FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK

Lord, Teach Us to Pray

We say the Lord's Prayer together every Sunday. It is a beautiful prayer, given to us by Jesus when the disciples asked how they should pray. This simple, short prayer is full of wonderful theology, full of bold statements about who God is and who we are. But in its repetition, I wonder if sometimes we overlook the powerful words we are praying. This Sunday, I will be beginning a sermon series on the Lord's Prayer, focusing on one phrase a week. As we go deeper into the Lord's Prayer, I pray that the prayer will become more than just words...I pray that this prayer will become a way of life.

As a way to prepare for my sermons every week, I would like to invite you to help me dive deeper into the Lord's Prayer. Each Monday at 1:30 p.m., I invite you to join me at the church for study on the phrase of the Lord's Prayer for the upcoming Sunday. Beginning on July 2, when we will study "Our Father, who art in heaven," I hope you will join me in the Parlor for study, conversation, and prayer. In my own study and preparations for this sermon series, I will be reading a few books — The Lord and His Prayer by N.T. Wright and Lord, Teach Us: The Lord's Prayer and the Christian Life by William H. Willimon and Stanley Hauerwas. If you are interested in reading along with me, please do. And if you have resources on the Lord's Prayer that you think I should know about, please share them!

I am really looking forward to diving deep into the powerful words of the Lord's Prayer throughout this sermon series! I hope you are, too.

July 1 - Teach Us to Pray

Luke 11:1-4 and Romans 8:26-27

July 8 - Our Father, who art in Heaven

Matthew 6:9-13 and Romans 8:14-17

Guiding Questions: How do you address God? What images of God do you most identify with? Father? Mother? Shepherd? King? What is God's position in the universe? Does God reside primarily in Heaven?

July 15 – Hallowed be thy name

Luke 11:1-4 and Job 38:1-7

Guiding Questions: How do you express God's holiness? How do you define holiness?

July 22 - Pastor Jackie away at Craig Springs Second Triple Camp - Hymn Sing

July 29 - Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven

Matthew 6:9-13 and Isaiah 11:1-9

Guiding Questions: What does the Kingdom of God look like? How does God's kingdom come to earth? What would it mean to want what God wants? How do you know what God's will is? How can we make earth more heaven-like? What is heaven like?

August 5 - Give us this day our daily bread

Luke 11:1-4 and Exodus 16:2-5, 13-26

Guiding Questions: Do we really trust God to give us what we need? What would it be like to live with only what you really need?

August 12 - Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us

Matthew 6:9-15 and Matthew 18:21-33

Guiding Questions: What do we need forgiveness for? Some Bible translations use "debts" instead of "trespasses;" what do each of these indicate about the nature of sin? Why should we forgive others? Why is it so hard to forgive?

August 19 - And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil

Matthew 6:9-15 and Psalm 91:1-2, 9-16

Guiding Questions: Does God tempt us? Does Satan? Is it wrong to be tempted? Do you believe in evil spirits or powers? Do you believe there is evil in each of us? How are we delivered from something that is within us?

August 26 - For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever and ever

Luke 11:1-4 and Philippians 4:4-7

Guiding Questions: What does it mean for God to be ruler over everything? How does that affect the way we pray? Do you believe that God is all-powerful? What does it mean to give God glory? If God is eternal, how do you think God views us and our world?

September 2 - Amen

Psalm 72:19 and 2 Corinthians 1:20

Guiding Questions: The word 'Amen' is a declaration of affirmation found throughout the Old and New Testament. We often use it as an ending to our prayers, but it can be so much more. What does 'Amen' mean to you? Do you ever find yourself saying 'Amen'? In what contexts?

September 9 - Interactive worship based on the Lord's Prayer

OUTREACH DEPARTMENT

A.C.T.S. (Area Congregations Together in Service) – Bethany has been a part of A.C.T.S. for several years, and we use them as a referral for people who call our church looking for financial help. Before A.C.T.S. helps a person or family, they do an interview for an assessment of needs. They do not automatically give money on the spot. After the assessment, if they find a true need that they feel meets their criteria, they will help with rent, utilities, etc. They also will provide financial counseling to help the individual better manage his/her finances. I think it is fair to say that they offer a hand up, not a hand out.

In order to continue being able to refer folks to A.C.T.S., we have to contribute \$600 per year. On **Sunday, July 1, and Sunday, July 8**, we will be asking for contributions for A.C.T.S. so that we can continue to support this worthwhile organization. Please prayerfully consider what you are able to give. Please put "A.C.T.S." in the memo section of your check.

A Church-goer wrote a letter to the editor of a newspaper and complained that it made no sense to go to church every Sunday.
